Do you have public computers to use?

We do. We have 4 public use computers with access to the internet and common Microsoft Office products. Print outs cost \$0.25 per page.

Do you have a photocopier?

We have a black and white photocopies. \$0.25 per page.

Welcome to the Gray Library

We have the resources to meet the educational, recreational, and entertainment needs of a growing and vibrant community. Books, periodicals, movies, music, audiobooks and electronic resources including e-book and audiobook downloads are now available to you!

As part of the statewide online catalog system Minerva, our users gain access to more than **six million** library items from a consortium of over 60 academic, public, and special libraries across Maine.

Is there a limit on what I can borrow?

A patron can have a total of 35 items checked out at once. We limit movies (7), music (6), video games (3) and TV series (3) checkouts per card.

Using Library Materials

Can I check out without my card?

If you don't have your card, you may use a valid photo ID to checkout materials.

However, you will need the card for online access.

How will I know when to bring them back?

At your request, we can print you a date due receipt at the point of checkout. Additionally, you may check the status of your materials online, or give us a call.

May I renew what I take out?

If no one else has requested your item, it may be renewed. All items may be renewed twice. You may renew materials through our online catalog, over the phone, or by bringing your card to the circulation desk.

What if I want something that's popular?

Through our circulation system, we are able to place "holds" on popular items so they will be set aside for you once they are returned. You may speak to anyone at the circulation desk about placing holds or receiving instructions on how to do it from home.

Using Library Materials

What if my materials are late?

There is a daily fee assessed on overdue items. Fees will accrue up to \$5 per item for adult and children's' materials.

If I have fines, can I still check out?

Patrons may continue to check out until they have accrued fines in excess of \$5.

What if I don't return what I've borrowed?

Items that are still checked out 2-weeks after the due date will be automatically billed. The amount of the bill will be retail price of the item at the time of purchase. Additionally, a \$3.00 Processing Fee is applied to billed materials. Once the item is returned, only overdue and processing fees will be assessed.

But the dog ate it!

Damaged materials, whether dog nibbled or not, need to be replaced. You will be billed the replacement cost of the item.

What if I receive damaged goods?

If there is a flaw with your item, please inform the staff when you return it.
